MUMBAI: The BSE Sensex on Thursday gained 83 points at 62,494.20 as buying was seen in



commodities, energy and consumer discretionary goods and services stocks. The Nifty rose 21.90 points at 18,582.40.

The Sensex registered intra day high and low at 62,633.56 and 62,320.18 points respectively.

The Nifty recorded intra day high and low at 18,625 and 18,536 points

respectively. The Mid Cap moved up by 0.03 per cent and Small Cap by 0.14 per cent.

In 30 scrips 16 advanced, while 14 declined.

The gainers were Axis Bank by 1.56 per cent to Rs 929, L & T by 1.27 per cent to Rs 2150.50, Indus Ind Bank by 1.21 per cent to Rs 992.60, Kotak Bank by 1.09 per cent to Rs 1890.20, TCS by 0.85 per cent to Rs 3351.95 and Powergrid by 0.79 per cent to Rs 219.45.

AI to fully refurbish aircraft cabin interiors

NEW DELHI: Air India on Thursday said it would invest USD 400 million to refurbish cabin interiors of entire legacy wide-body aircraft.

The refurbishment will see a complete overhaul of existing cabin interiors, including the addition of latest generation seats and best in-class inflight entertainment across all classes, a statement from the company said.

In addition, the refurbishment will see the introduction of a premium economy cabin on both fleets.

The first class cabin will also be retained on

the 777s. Air India has engaged leading London-based product design companies, JPA Design and Trendworks, to assist with the cabin interior design elements of the refurbishment programme, the statement from Tata-owned carrier said.

Campbell Wilson, MD and CEO, Air India said, "Under our Vihaan.AI transformation program, Air India has committed to attain the highest standards of product and service befitting of a world class airline. We know that, at present, the cabin product on our 40 legacy widebody aircraft falls short of

this standard. Although the project commenced some months ago, we are delighted to now publicly announce this significant investment on a complete interior refit, and we are confident that, when revealed, the new interiors will delight customers and show Air India in a new light."

"We are working closely with partners to accelerate the refit process as fast as possible and, in the meantime, leasing in at least 11 new widebody aircraft with brand new interiors to improve our offering at the earliest opportunity," he said.

Over 765000 fans visit Qatar

DOHA: Qatar has received just over 765,000 visitors so far for the World Cup finals, according to a report published by the Supreme Committee for Delivery and Legacy (SC), which organizes the tournament.

The report shows that the first 17 days of competition attracted 765,859 international visitors, over half of whom have now departed. It is hoped that supporters of the last eight teams left in the tournament will now arrive to boost numbers for the quarterfinals and semifinal stages, which

kick off on Friday.

The report also confirms that 3.09 million tickets for games have been sold to 1.33 million ticketholders. 2.65 million fans attended the first 52 matches.

The number of visitors is slightly below predictions, but has meant that there has been less pressure on the limited accommodation in the country and has also meant there have not been the anticipated problems of overcrowding or traffic around stadiums or in the center of Doha.

Rupee up 16 paise

MUMBAI: The Rupee on Thursday advanced 16 paise, at 82.31 in the opening trade against the US Dollar on selling of US Dollars by bankers and exporters, dealers at Foreign Exchange said.

The local unit gained on weak Dollar against other world currencies.

Women in Blue to face Australia

MUMBAI: The 'Women in Blue', in their preparation for the ICC Women's T20 World Cup next year, face the current titles holders Australia in a five-match T20i series which is to be held in Mumbai from December 9 to 20.

The series will be a

perfect opportunity for both teams to get a better understanding of their strengths and weaknesses as well as to gauge the tactics and gameplay of their counterparts.

The series is more than just attaining bragging rights, but also a much-needed opportunity to build up steam and momentum ahead of the ICC Women's T20 World Cup next year. With both teams deemed as favourites to win the World Cup, the stakes have never been

this high.

Both India and Australia's women's teams have had a successful year in international cricket, winning accolades in multi-national events in 2022. India won the women's Asia Cup 2022, for a record seventh time beating Sri Lanka comprehensively in the finals, while Australia was crowned the maiden winners of the Commonwealth Games Cricket in August this year.

The Indian women's team returns to action after

a break of two months, riding on the success of their Asia Cup victory. Expect to see stars like Harmanpreet Kaur, Alyssa Healy, and Smriti Mandhana set the stage on fire as they look to be in pristine form ahead of an exciting year for women's cricket in 2023.

BCCI announces schedule for home series against SL, NZ & Aus

MUMBAI: The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) on Thursday announced the schedule for the upcoming home series against Sri Lanka, New Zealand, and Australia.

India's 2022-23, international home season will commence with a three-match T20I & three-match ODI series against Sri Lanka in January.

The action will then move to a three-match ODI series against New Zealand wherein Hyderabad, Raipur and Indore will play hosts.

The second ODI on January 21 will be a marquee ODI for the city of Raipur as they will host their first international fixture.

Team India will

also play a three-match T20I series against New Zealand.

The Australia tour of India for the Border-Gavaskar Trophy will kickstart in Nagpur from February 9.

India will play the next three Test matches in Delhi, Dharamsala & Ahmedabad. This will also be the last edition of the

Border-Gavaskar Trophy which will be a 4-match Test series feature.

The home series will then conclude with a three-match ODI series that will be held in Mumbai, Vizag and Chennai.
