

ESSENTIALS SENT TO 41 TRAPPED INSIDE UTTARAKHAND TUNNEL

Rescuers make visual contact

AFTER A SERIES of setbacks, the 10th day of the operation to rescue 41 workers trapped inside the under-construction Silkyara-Barkot tunnel brought a small sense of relief to their families after the administration finally established a visual communication with the men. A six-inch pipe that had successfully reached the men on Monday to supply essential commodities was used to send an endoscopic camera to the other side. A 2-minute, 23-second video released by the administration shows the camera reaching the other end of the pipe at 3.45 am Tuesday, and a rescuer asking the men

peeking into the pipe if they are okay. "If all are okay, show your faces to the camera, raise your hand and smile. We will soon reach you, don't worry. Slowly pull the camera and show everyone," said a rescuer as a worker put his hand inside the pipe and pulled the camera. At 3.53 am, a rescuer instructed them to clear the camera using a piece of cloth. When the camera went inside, giving a wide-angle view of the tunnel, the rescuers started recognising the men. "Vishal Vishal. This one is Vishwajeet. The one next to him is Subodh," said a rescuer outside, pointing at the face on a screen. As operation in-charge Colonel Deepak Patil mentioned they should clear the pipe using water and a compressor, a rescuer announced the same and instructed the

workers to put the camera back in the pipe and move away. Meanwhile, the rescue operation moved at a moderate pace on Tuesday with various government agencies being mobilised for their assigned

tasks. According to a brief issued by the ministry of road transport and highways, the National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation has resumed horizontal boring from the Silkyara end, while the debris is, to rescue workers using a boring machine. This is one of five approaches being taken by rescuers. In Delhi, top officials held a briefing on the rescue operation. They, too, said that horizontal boring from the Silkyara end to rescue workers has resumed and if no obstacle comes in the way, the men would be rescued in two to two and a half days. Anurag Jain, secretary, ministry of road, transport and highways, said: "Every effort has its expected time limit. When we started the work, the augur was supposed to be the best and the fastest... We have started the work again with the American augur machine; if it is successful then there will remain only two-three days' work."

Need to address terror, Gaza crisis, says Jaishankar

UNDERLINING THE "VERY complex and challenging situation" against the backdrop of the ongoing Israel-Hamas war, external affairs minister S Jaishankar on Tuesday outlined India's position on three aspects: terrorism, humanitarian crisis in Gaza and the rights of Palestinians.

This points to the complex diplomatic tightrope walk that Delhi has to do, as it faces strategic partners on the many sides of the conflict. With Australian foreign minister Penny Wong by his side after their bilateral meeting, Jaishankar said, "There are different aspects of the very complex and challenging situation that we face today. One, of course, is terrorism. What happened on October 7, and we think nationally, as well as the international community that we should never compromise on terrorism... We should be very clear about it." He said that the issue of hostages is included in this aspect. "There is a second set of issues and this is the humanitarian crisis that we see in Gaza today. "The need for humanitarian assistance is very urgent, and observance of international humanitarian law," he said. India has sent two batches of humanitarian aid so far. "And the third set of issues relate to the rights and the

future of the Palestinians. That too, has to have a solution. And that solution, in our view, and in the view of many countries in the world, can only come from a two-state solution. So today I would say, the... the situation in West Asia, you have these three broad sets of issues. We have to find a way by which all of them are addressed." Framing the challenge, he said, "When we hear one asserted at the expense of another, that is not really going to lead to a way forward. So I think the challenge for all of us, collectively, is how do all these aspects... How do we deal with all of them? I think that is really what we discussed." Wong said the humanitarian situation in Gaza is "dire", "catastrophic" and "human suffering is widespread". "We share the view that what occurred on October 7 was an act of terrorism and it needs to be unequivocally condemned. We share the view that the hostages should be released and we repeat our call for that," she said.

Israel lists Lashkar-e-Taiba as 'terrorist organisation'

ISRAEL ON TUESDAY re-affirmed its declaration of Pakistan-based Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) as a 'terror organisation' ahead of the 15th year anniversary of the 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks in which 166 persons, including six Jews, were killed. "Yes, I can confirm it. It's not a new thing and it is actually a re-phrasing because of a bureaucratic error but it is not a new thing," Israeli foreign ministry spokesman, Lior Haia, said. Haia's statement came after a press release by the Embassy of Israel in India ear-

lier in the day said: "To symbolise the marking of the 15th year of commemoration of the Mumbai terror attacks, the state of Israel has listed Lashkar-e-Taiba as a 'Terror Organisation'." The re-affirmation comes weeks after Israel said that the time had come for India to declare Hamas a terror organisation. Hamas, which controls the Gaza Strip since 2007, used land, sea and air routes to launch an attack on Israel territories that killed more than 1,200 people, mostly civilians on October 7. It prompted Jerusalem to declare war on the Islamic outfit, killing more than 11,000 people. In almost a similar manner, on November 26, 2008, ten

Pakistani terrorists entered the south Mumbai areas through a sea route and attacked a number of places, including Chabad House, a Jewish centre. The indiscriminate attack killed 166 people, including six Jews and 18 security personnel. Six Jews were killed at Nariman House, more popularly known as the Chabad House, considered by many Israelis as a "shared pain". The terror siege continued for three days during which more than 300 were wounded even as the coordinated shooting and bombing attacks at 12 sites also damaged properties, including the heritage building of the sea-facing Taj Mahal Palace Hotel.
