German Minister observes...

detailed exercise that the ECI conducts for over 950 million voters across 1.1 million polling stations, co-opting 11 million polling personnel ensuring robust electoral processes for conducting free, fair, inclusive, accessible and participative elections. The German Foreign Minister while interacting with the Commission appreciated the vast exercise of

electoral management by ECI in the largest democracy in the world given the challenges of diverse geography, culture and electorate in India. The German Minister was briefed about the extensive use of technology by the ECI in the conduct of elections broadly under three verticals of voters' participation, political parties/candidates and election machinery logistics.

World Bank revises...

In October, the World Bank had cut India's GDP growth forecast to 6.5 per cent from 7.5 per cent earlier. Now, it has upgraded the projection to 6.9 per cent for 2022-23 (April 2022-March 2023). The report titled 'Navigating the Storm', said while the deteriorating external environment will weigh on India's growth prospects, the economy is relatively well

positioned to weather global spillovers compared to most other emerging markets. Impact of a tightening global monetary policy cycle, slowing global growth and elevated commodity prices will mean that the Indian economy will experience lower growth in 2022-23 compared to 2021-22 (8.7 per cent), it said.

Adani, Nadar, Soota among...

Adani was listed for having pledged Rs 60,000 crores (USD 7.7 billion) when he turned 60 in June this year. The pledge makes him one of India's most generous philanthropists, the press release said.

Self-made billionaire and philanthropist Shiv Nadar counts among the top donors in India, having channelled close to USD 1 billion of his wealth over a few decades to various social causes through the eponymous Shiv Nadar Foundation.

The money will address healthcare, education, and skill development and will be channelled through the family's Adani Foundation, which was founded in 1996. Each year, the foundation helps nearly 3.7 million people across India.

This year he donated Rs 11,600 crore (USD 142 million) to the foundation he established in 1994, intending to create an equitable, merit-based society by empowering individuals through education. In his address at the meeting, NSA Ajit Doval said connectivity with Central Asian countries remained a key priority for India and that New

Delhi stands ready to cooperate, invest and build connectivity in the region. On threat of terror groups, he said financial support is the "lifeblood" of terrorism and greater priority should be accorded to counter terror financing. Describing Central Asia as India's "extended neighbourhood", Doval said New Delhi accords "highest priority" to this region, adding Afghanistan is an important issue "concerning all of us".

Mah, K'taka border row...

"There is no relationship with upcoming assembly elections and Karnataka's stand on the border issue. For many years now, it is Maharashtra that has been raking up the issue," he said. Maharashtra has raised the dispute and there is reaction from Karnataka, he added. Speaking to reporters, he maintained there is harmony between people of both States and it should not be disturbed. "The case is before the Supreme Court, our stand is both legal and constitutional, so we are confident

that we will win the legal battle. So there is no question of us wanting to create an issue out of it for the sake of elections. We are committed to protect the state's borders and our people, and also the interests of Kannadigas living in Maharashtra, Telangana and Kerala" he added. A Maharashtra ministerial delegation that was supposed to visit Belagavi and hold discussions with a pro-Marathi group postponed its schedule while Kannada organisations staged a protest in Belagavi.

Fadnavis speaks to Bommai

Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis to take up the matter with Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai on Tuesday and extract an assurance on protection of vehicles. Amid a raging border row between the two States, the video showed some people throwing stones at vehicles entering Karnataka from the Maharashtra side near a toll booth at Hirebagwadi in Belagavi district of the adjoining State. Sources close to the

Maharashtra Deputy CM said, "Fadnavis made a phone call to Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai and expressed his disappointment over the Hirebagwadi incident." "The Karnataka Chief Minister assured Fadnavis of strong action against the perpetrators. He also assured Fadnavis that vehicles entering Karnataka from Maharashtra will be given proper protection," the sources said.

Nobody should go to sleep empty stomach, says SC

It is Govt's duty to ensure foodgrains reach the last man

NEW DELHI, Dec 6 (PTI)

IT IS our culture to ensure nobody goes to sleep empty stomach, the Supreme Court said on Tuesday and asked the Central Government to see to it that foodgrains under the National Food Security Act (NFSA) reaches the last man. A bench of Justices M R Shah and Hima Kohli directed the Centre to submit a fresh chart with the number of migrant and unorganised sector workers registered on eShram portal. "It is the duty of the Central Government to ensure foodgrains under NFSA are reaching the last man. We are not saying that Centre is not doing

anything, the Union of India has ensured foodgrains to people during COVID. At the same time, we have to see it continues. It is our culture (to ensure) that nobody goes to sleep empty stomach," the bench said. It was hearing on its own a public interest matter related to the plight of migrant workers during the COVID pandemic and the resultant lockdowns. Advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for three social activists Anjali Bharadwaj, Harsh Mander and Jagdeep Chhokar, said the country's population has increased after the 2011 census and so has the number of beneficiaries covered under the

NFSA. He submitted many eligible and needy beneficiaries will be deprived of the benefit under the law if it is not enforced effectively. Bhushan said the Government is claiming the per capita income of people has increased in recent years, but added India has slipped rapidly in global hunger index. Additional Solicitor General Aishwarya Bhat, appearing for the Centre, submitted there are 81.35 crore beneficiaries under NFSA, a very large number even in the Indian context. The ASG said the 2011 census has not stopped the Government from adding more people to the list of beneficiaries which is growing.

ICMR website hacked 6000 times in a day: Official

HACKERS allegedly tried to breach the website of the apex health research body ICMR but their attempts have been foiled, according to a Government official. The official said that hackers apparently from Hong Kong tried to attack the website of the Indian Council of Medical Research around 6000 times in a span of 24 hours on November 30. The attacks come close to the heels of the alleged ransomware attack that had paralysed AIIMS online services here. "The contents of the ICMR website are safe. The site is hosted at NIC Data Centre, hence the firewall is from NIC which they regularly update. The attack has been prevented successfully," the official said.

Booking for Attari-Wagah retreat ceremony to go online from January 1

NEW DELHI, Dec 6 (PTI)

VISITORS planning to witness the daily national flag lowering and retreat ceremony at the Attari-Wagah front along the India-Pakistan international border in Punjab can book their seats online from the next year. The BSF, that guards the frontier and conducts the event, has launched a web portal for this purpose -- http://attari.bsf.gov.in. "Welcome to JCP Attari website Bookings to view the Joint Retreat Ceremony can now be made online. Bookings Open from 1st January 2023," the BSF said in a public message on its Twitter handle. At per the present system, people reach the retreat area without a prior booking and the BSF allows them to take seats in the gallery on production of an ID card. The new facility is not chargeable and visitors will be initially allowed to book 12 persons in one group, 48 hours prior to the desired day, after furnishing photo ID card details online, a senior BSF officer said.

The booking details will be sent through an SMS on the mobile number of the group leader or the first visitor listed, he said. The Attari border front, also called the joint check post or JCP, is located about 26 kms from Amritsar city and hundreds of domestic visitors, foreign tourists and locals go everyday to watch the daily flag lowering and retreat ceremony conducted in a synchronised fashion by smartly-dressed BSF personnel along with their counterparts Pakistan Rangers, on their side known as Wagah. A senior officer said the website will start accepting the bookings from January 1 and an individual would be initially able to book for a group of total 12 people, 48 hours prior to the event, that starts between 3:30 pm-4 pm every evening. The BSF has now numbered the seats in the viewing gallery so that it can hold about 20,000-25,000 visitors daily.
